A Note from Director, Bob Swann:

After Pastor Bob Dargie's message last Sunday's morning about "Our Comforter" I read in John 6:63. it tells us that the Holy Spirit is the one who quickens our lives as our Comforter." Please make this a matter of prayer with us. Better news is that Grace Baptist Church now has 168 faithful members in good standing.
